# The Story of our Friendship Hall Building

In 2018 we began planning for a new Friendship Hall Building to replace our old Friendship Hall which was comprised of the old Movie Theater concession stand plus a 1960's addition. It served the church well, but we had worn it out. It had also been badly damaged by storms in recent years.

A Capital Campaign was launched to begin the planning phase of the new project. Our Building Committee selected McCree General Contractors & Architects to begin our work with them on a design for the new building that would include a large gathering space, kitchen, chapel, offices and handicap accessible restrooms. Financing was secured through Disciples Church Extension Fund for the \$2 million project. Construction began in March 2019 and by November we were moving into our new building. The first event in Friendship Hall was the Ordination Service for our first full-time Associate Minister, Rev. Melissa Frantz!

With our new Friendship Hall built, our attention turned to paying off the \$1.75 million debt. Our next Capital Campaign, "Our Journey Continues", provided the inspiration and dedication for us to make regular payments and chip away at the principal through additional investments. And thanks to the generosity of our church family, today our loan balance is \$251,607.

That's not all though. We still have about \$132,950 in our previous Capital Campaign account. Apply that to our loan balance and we are only needing \$118,657 to completely eliminate our mortgage debt!

Friends, we have been able to do this while continuing to fully fund our Drive In Church ministries and our outreach efforts to our community and around the world. In fact, over the past five years we have given away almost \$500,000 in total outreach. And again, this is because of your amazing generosity and the prayerful guidance of our Great God!

You have the opportunity through your gift or pledge to Circle of Generosity to take part in writing the next chapter of this incredible story. Help keep the circle going and expanding as together we live into God's truth revealed in Luke 6:38 - *"Give, and it will be given to you - a good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over..."* And just as a circle has no beginning and no end, so does God's blessing on our lives and God's abundant generosity today and always.

## ***What else will we be able to accomplish when you support the Circle of Generosity Capital Campaign?***

As we've grown into our Friendship Hall we've identified some issues limiting full accessibility that need to be addressed.

There are other projects on the campus as well. Here are a few things we'd like to do:

- Build outdoor deck space with handicap accessible ramp providing outdoor seating/workspace on the west side of Friendship Hall.
- Add motorized door access to both east and west main doors into the Friendship Hall building.
- Remodel and provide accessibility to the lower-level restrooms in the Altar Building.
